Group 9 allow a maximum of 8 Interchanges in XXXX Gold First Grade Fixtures

The following rules need to be followed when interchanging players:

- 1. Interchange may only occur during general play, after any scoring has been completed, or if play has been temporarily suspended by the Referee (e.g. injury or caution)
- 2. Maximum of two (2) interchange of players may take place at any one time
- 3. A replaced player MUST CROSS THE TOUCHLINE or DEAD BALL LINE prior to his replacement taking the field
- 4. Interchange must not be made after the referee has ordered a scrum until the scrum has been completed.

Blood Bin: (Marked B)

Only the Referee can determine whether a player should be put in the Blood Bin. If a player is taken off without the knowledge of the Referee it will be deemed as a normal replacement. Any player returning to the field of play after being in the Blood Bin at the instruction of the referee must exchange places with the player that replaced him. If a different player comes off, he shall be deemed to be a replacement.

Concussion Subs: (Marked HIA)

Players removed from the field with suspected concussion are a free replacement however the player must not return to the field and must be referred to a doctor and follow the Concussion Policy around return to play.
